Trip to The Salmonberry School

On May 29th, three members of the Holistic Teaching and Learning Club drove to Orcas Island, WA to visit The Salmonberry School (ages 4-12). Anu Ayers, Stephanie Hougan, and Gianna Lowry had the opportunity to observe the values and practices of Salmonberry upclose and personal.

"Is it time yet?" is a statement that gives insight into how the students at Salmonberry come to school every day. After the head of school, Paul Freedman, gave the student a nod showing that it was time for school to start, the child proceeded to run through the gates with a big smile on their face.

Anu Ayers recalls the magic of Yes Day, an all-day event that the Otters (ages 6 & 7) held on Thursday, May 30th. According to their instructor, Aliza Diepenbrock, Yes Day is a day to honor the students' growing ability to say "yes!" to the community and for the island to say "yes!" in return.



In a discussion with Stephanie Hougan, she recalled the presence of emotional awareness among the students. All ages of children at Salmonberry have been supported in a way that allows them to learn skills that help them emotionally regulate and be mindful of others. Stephanie shared that it was amazing to be welcomed by the Eagles group (ages 10 & 12) in a way that was kind, respectful, and full of curiosity.

"They are conscientious about each other's emotions and experiences," Gianna Lowry said, "The lead teacher of this group is aware of the importance of autonomy, competence, and belonging and is active in fostering these things."
